

Terms and conditions

Food waste trial

1. The food waste trial is open to residents, aged 18 and over ('you') of St Edmundsbury Borough Council ('the council').
2. The council will provide you with one Fresh Pod container and a chet ('the trial product') for you to partake in the trial. Your use of the trial product will be subject to these terms and conditions.
3. The trial is limited to a specific geographical area of St Edmundsbury and it for **residential use only**. To see if your area is covered please visit <http://www.westsuffolk.gov.uk/foodwaste>
4. Provision of the trial product is at the discretion of the council and subject to availability. There is no other alternative or free replacement of the trial product or cash available.
5. There is a maximum of one Fresh Pod per household on the trial and there is no return of the product if you later decide not to use it or participate in the trial.
6. You are responsible for the general use of the trial product whilst in your possession. The council does not provide ongoing replacement of the trial product.
7. If you would like to submit a review, please complete a short online feedback survey or complete a feedback form. The council will use the details provided by you support our food waste reduction project. Personal contact details will be used by the council to contact you with further information about reducing food waste and Fresh Pod. All personal information will be processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. By providing this information you are consenting to its use as detailed.
8. The trial product is provided without charge. Accordingly, the council makes no warranties, representations or gives any undertakings, whether express, implied or statutory, including without limitation, as to merchantability, non-infringement or fitness for a particular purpose in relation to trial product or the content.
9. To the extent permitted by law, in no event shall the council or a third party supplier be liable to you for any incidental, consequential, indirect, or

special damages, even if the council or third party supplier have been advised of the possibility of such damages.

Prize draw

1. This competition is open to all residents of St Edmundsbury Borough Council except that employees of the council, their immediate families or anyone professionally connected with the operation of the trial are excluded from participation. All entrants must complete the registration (online, at events or as instructed by the council) and supply the council with their name, postal address and email address. The council will only ever use these details for the purposes of administering this prize draw. This information will not be shared with any third party without your consent, unless required by law.

2. Only one entry will be accepted per household.

3. The competition will be run in August, September and October 2017 only (the qualifying months). There will be one main prize and 10 runners up prizes drawn at the end of each qualifying month. All eligible registrations will be included in each prize draw subject to meeting the entry deadline. For note, you only need to register once. You will be automatically entered into the prize draws that are available to you. For example, if you meet the August entry deadline, you will be included in the prize draws in August, September and October. Details of the entry deadlines and notification of winners is as follows:

4. The winner will be selected at random from the correct entries received.

5. The winner will be contacted personally by an officer of the council.

6. If the prize is unclaimed after 28 days it will be deemed to have been forfeited and the council reserves the right to either offer the prize to the entrant whose name is next drawn at random, or to re-offer the prize in any future competition.

7. The prize must be taken as stated. There will be no cash alternative.

8. The council does not accept any responsibility for late or lost entries due to internet services. All entries must be made using the online form or official registration form and no responsibility can be accepted for entries lost,



delayed, mislaid or for any technical failure or for any event which may cause the competition to be disrupted or corrupted.

9. Entrants must supply full details as required above, and comply with all rules to be eligible for the prize. No responsibility is accepted for ineligible entries or entries made fraudulently.

10. The council reserves the right to cancel the competition at any stage, if deemed necessary in their opinion, and if circumstances arise outside of its control.

11. Entrants will be deemed to have accepted these rules and to agree to be bound by them when entering this competition. Failure to comply with the rules may result in disqualification.
