

Top tips for easy access

- Most of the town centre has dropped kerbs although some of the streets have uneven surfaces, such as York stone.
- Pedestrian routes into town have even footpaths but there are some slopes. If you discover a problem please call our engineering services on 01284 757319 or email engserv@stedsbc.gov.uk
- The Athenaeum, Art Gallery, Moyse's Hall Museum, Parkway multi-storey car park and the borough council offices all have lifts and the Tourist Information Centre, bus station and train station are also accessible.
- The Abbey Gardens has tarmac paths, accessible toilets, an accessible tea room, a play area with facilities for children who are less able and a sensory garden and herb garden.
- RADAR keys are available from borough council offices on Angel Hill.
- All bays are available for accessible parking if a blue badge is displayed. All blue badge parking in the town is free.
